Frequently Asked Questions

If I do not have symptoms, can I still get tested? The tests will be available to anyone with or without symptoms who is interested in getting tested even if they do not have health insurance.

Will my health insurance be billed for the test? Yes. People with health insurance are strongly encouraged to check with their insurance carrier about costs associated with being tested.

What if I do not have health insurance? People without insurance will not be charged and people with insurance will only be charged the allowable amount by their insurance company.

Do I need a referral? No.

Do I need to call ahead? While you are encouraged to call ahead for a phone evaluation, appointments or calling ahead are not necessary. To complete an evaluation over the phone please call Priority Urgent Care (860-454-0678).

What are symptoms of COVID-19? Symptoms of COVID-19 are varied and can range from flu like illness, abdominal symptoms, and conjunctivitis. Fever and shortness of breath are the more concerning symptoms, but patients can have malaise or generalized fatigue as well. Anyone with these symptoms can be evaluated for testing.
