# **Everbridge** ~ Town of Somers Alert System

**Notification Program Overview...** The Town of Somers launched a mass notification service that allows us to alert you. You opt-in to enter your contact information and subscribe to notifications you care about.

The information you provide is protected and will not be used for any other purpose.

**How It Works...** When we issue a notification about a potential safety hazard or concern, you will receive a message on the voice or text communication methods that you have registered. If requested for the notification, you can confirm that you have received the message and you will not be contacted by any subsequent methods regarding that particular notification. If you do not confirm, the system will continue to attempt to reach you at all of the contact paths that you have registered.

**Sign up for Notifications...** Create an account & add your contact information into the Mass Notification system. You can stop receiving at any time by removing your contact information from your profile.







# SCAM ALERT

Recently, we learned about a new scam against seniors.


Please be aware of the following:

The Seniors Center is an organization that has been the subject of multiple scam warnings from government bodies and consumer advocacy groups. They use deceptive mailings and messaging tactics to solicit donations, often making false claims about "protecting Social Security benefits". Multiple government entities and advocacy groups have warned people to throw away any mail received from The Seniors Center or related entities like The Seniors Trust. Please see example below.

Authorities emphasize that this organization has no ability to protect or influence Social

has no ability to protect or influence Social Security programs. While the company claims to be a non-profit organization, its materials often state that donations are not tax-deductible, which is a red flag for a legitimate charity. If you receive mail associated with this P.O. Box (P.O. Box 97111 Washington DC 20090) or organization, it is recommended to

throw away the solicitation letters immediately. Do not send money or personal information. Never provide credit card or bank account information in response to these solicitations. You can report the fraud or scam to the Federal Trade Commission at reportfraud.ftc.gov or contact your local or state consumer protection office.
